Frozen Jr. AUDITIONS Saturday, May 14 at 12pm



The enchanting modern classic from Disney is ready for your Broadway Junior stars! Frozen JR. is based on the 2018 Broadway musical, and brings Elsa, Anna, and the magical land of Arendelle to life, onstage.

Theatre kids with experience, ages 7-18, will have a great time in our high intensity 3-week camp which culminates in 4 fully produced performances

of *Frozen Jr.* Kids who have *auditioned in advance* will then try out for roles on the first morning of camp and jump right into rehearsals for staging, dancing, singing and tech. This year camp will meet for one week at the PARC and then move to the theatre for the final two weeks. Camp is from July 25 - August 12 with performances August 11-14.

Auditions before registration are required. There is only one more audition date left for interested campers - Saturday, May 14th. The auditions are at 12pm and will take place at the Performing Arts Resource Center (PARC) located at 70 Salt Spring Dr. Students do not have to prepare anything for this audition (though if they come ready to sing we will be happy to hear it!), we'll lead everyone through some music, dance and vocal exercises. In the On Book series, island directors gather actors and friends to read new, classic, and prize-winning plays. May's On-Book selection is "Eurydice" by Sarah Ruhl, and is directed by Courtney Kessler-Jeffrey. This performance is Pay-What-You-Can at the door.

"Eurydice reimagines the classic myth of Orpheus and Eurydice not through Orpheus's infamous pilgrimage to retrieve his bride, but through the eyes of its heroine. Dying too young on her wedding day, Eurydice must journey to the underworld, where she reunites with her father and struggles to remember her lost love. With contemporary characters, plot twists, and a script written to be a playground for designers, the play is a fresh look at a timeless love story."
